In 2015, Yukihiro "Matz" Matsumoto, the creator of the Ruby language, announced the effort to make Ruby version 3 be three times the speed of Ruby 2.0 (video link: <http://confreaks.tv/videos/rubyconf2015-keynote-and-q-a-matz>).

AppFolio, Inc. announced that it would hire a full-time engineer to work on Ruby performance to assist with the Ruby 3 effort (source: <http://engineering.appfolio.com/appfolio-engineering/2015/11/18/ruby-3x3>).
